Sadly it appears to be prevalent in so many children's lives. Healthy anxiety lets us know that there is a threat that we should be aware of and make haste to fight or take flight. If there is no danger then it only robs one of the joy of life."

This workshop will be hands on where you will learn many creative interventions that can help these children manage their anxiety, both immediately and as long term coping strategies.

Using visual symbols that can be called upon in times of stress can reduce the pattern of repetitively returning to a state of anxiety. Recognising the level of anxiety and how this is manifest in behaviour and thinking will be covered. Using art you will learn many creative interventions that will assist you at your school and/or in your private practice. Most of these techniques are Leonie's own creations.
